1. Attendance, Introductions and Receipt of Minutes:

2. Acceptance of March Minutes

Called to order by Greg Rippy

The March meeting minutes were not completed at the time of the meeting. The meeting minutes for March and April will be presented at the May meeting for review and adoption.

3. Airport Planning Map:

The Airport, South Bridge Alignment was presented for review. Staff will finish installing the information on the Master Plan map and delivery to Commission members.

4. Municipal Code & Airport Rules/Regulations Changes Update/Lien Determination from Karl Hanlon:

The City Attorney has provided comments on the Lien Language, Staff will review and make changes to the language. Once the changes have been made, the document will be sent out to the Airport Commission.

5. Papi Lights:

The lights are having a problem with over-heating. The Airport Manager has reviewed the situation but has not had success in completely correcting the problem. The lights are operational, but the cabinet intermittently over heats and overloads the circuitry. Greg Rippy was going to have an electrician research LED lighting. Dick Weinberg stated that the lighting will need to meet FAA regulations.

6. Airport Manager's Report:

Fuel Prices are beginning to rise. The tank has approximately 2800 gallons. The assistant Public Works Director will check with finance to be sure the fund balance will support the purchase.

7. South Bridge Update:

The recent events of the South Bridge alignment discussed with the Airport Commission. A new alignment is being proposed to the south of the airport. The alignment will be evaluated through the ranking process, comparing the condemnation of the conservation easement to cost savings of an at-grade crossing at the Rio Grande Trail. Dave Brown stated concerns about the proposed alignment and the difference of the long public process were presented in the discussion.

8. Other:

The new hire for the Transportation Manager position, Tanya Allen, was introduced to the Commission. She will be starting mid-June.

9. Adjournment:

The meeting was adjourned by Greg Rippey at 8:01 AM.
