

When is Spring Cleanup?

Spring Cleanup is scheduled to run from Monday, April 17 through Friday, May 5, 2017. City crews will collect approved debris by zone. Please visit www.gwsco.gov/368/Spring-Cleanup for a zone map. **This service is available to city residents only.**

Where do I place my debris?

- In front of or adjacent to your property.
- Away from regular trash service.
- On public property only.
- Away from fences and buildings.
- Avoid landscaped areas.
- Avoid community piles.
- Place debris one day before zone start date.
- Place debris no later than 7 a.m. on zone start date.

What items will the city accept?

- Sorted debris from **city residents only**.
- One (1) full-sized pickup load of debris per residence.
- Tree limbs cut shorter than six (6) feet in length.
- Recyclable items including wood products, metals, and appliances separated from other debris.
- Refrigerated appliances with "Freon Free" certificate attached.

No Hazardous Waste
The city will not accept hazardous materials, including:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Paint, antifreeze, or gas ▪ Tires ▪ Waste motor oil ▪ Televisions, computers, or copiers ▪ Batteries ▪ Air cylinders or gas tanks

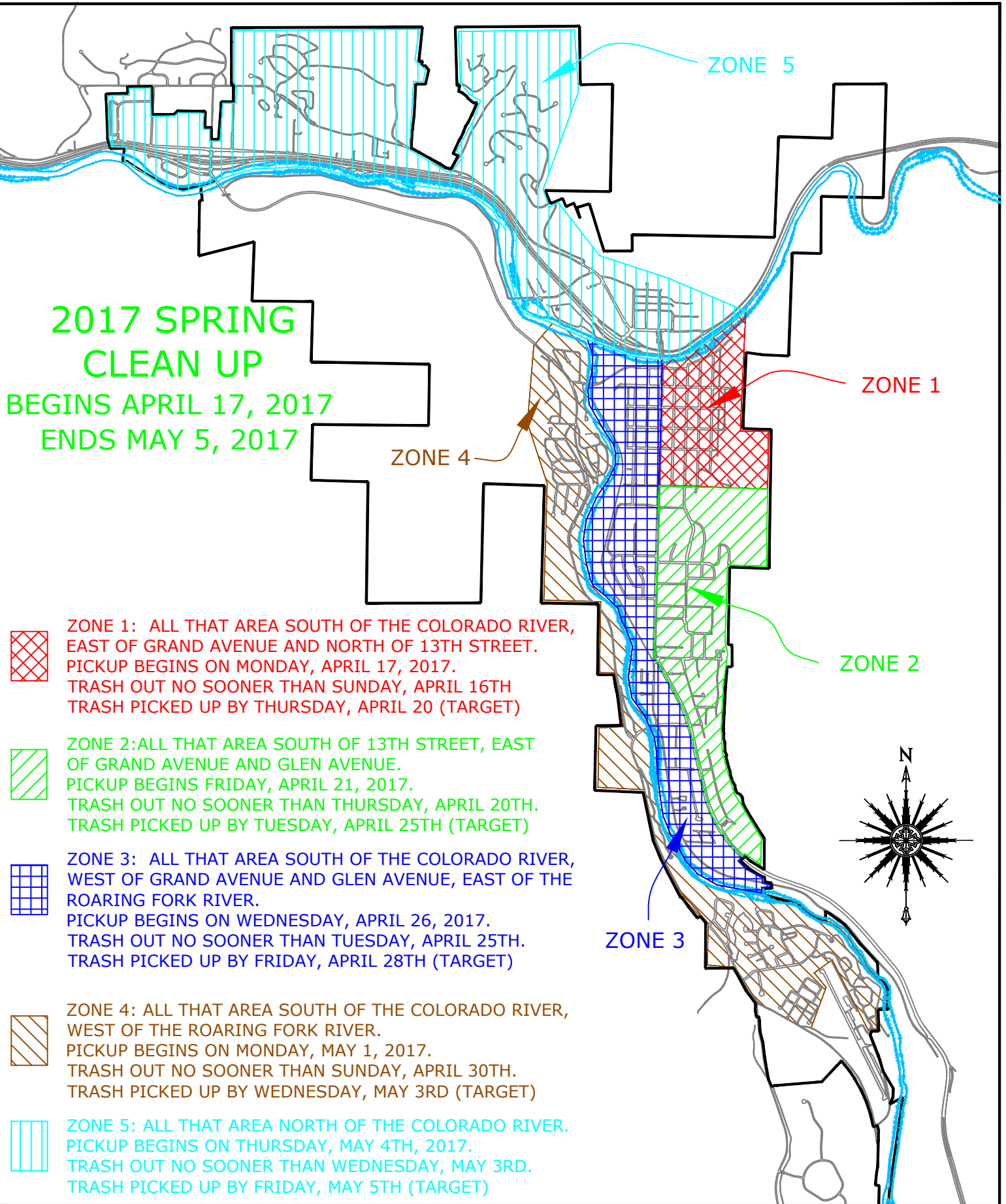
How do I report a violation?

ZONE 2: ALL THAT AREA SOUTH OF 13TH STREET, EAST OF GRAND AVENUE AND GLEN AVENUE. PICKUP BEGINS FRIDAY, APRIL 21, 2017. TRASH OUT NO SOONER THAN THURSDAY, APRIL 20TH. TRASH PICKED UP BY TUESDAY, APRIL 25TH (TARGET)

ZONE 3: ALL THAT AREA SOUTH OF THE COLORADO RIVER, WEST OF GRAND AVENUE AND GLEN AVENUE, EAST OF THE ROARING FORK RIVER. PICKUP BEGINS ON WEDNESDAY, APRIL 26, 2017. TRASH OUT NO SOONER THAN TUESDAY, APRIL 25TH. TRASH PICKED UP BY FRIDAY, APRIL 28TH (TARGET)

ZONE 4: ALL THAT AREA SOUTH OF THE COLORADO RIVER, WEST OF THE ROARING FORK RIVER. PICKUP BEGINS ON MONDAY, MAY 1, 2017. TRASH OUT NO SOONER THAN SUNDAY, APRIL 30TH. TRASH PICKED UP BY WEDNESDAY, MAY 3RD (TARGET)

ZONE 5: ALL THAT AREA NORTH OF THE COLORADO RIVER. PICKUP BEGINS ON THURSDAY, MAY 4TH, 2017. TRASH OUT NO SOONER THAN WEDNESDAY, MAY 3RD. TRASH PICKED UP BY FRIDAY, MAY 5TH (TARGET)
